

IMMA TRAINING - JULY 12, 2025

SIES School of Packaging - Packaging Technology Centre conducted a focused one-day training programme for members of the Indian Micro Fertilizers Manufacturers Association (IMMA), designed to deepen industry-wide understanding of packaging quality control on July 12th, 2025.

The sessions covered critical areas such as classification of packaging materials, sampling protocols, standards and specifications, and key parameters in chemical and micro-fertilizer packaging—including bag strength, sealing integrity, and labeling norms.

The training also featured live demonstrations of physical and chemical testing related to the packaging of fertilizers and agriculture-based products, offering hands-on exposure to methods that safeguard product integrity and compliance. It was a strong step forward in empowering stakeholders with tools for robust quality assurance and sustainable packaging practices.
